## SCHOOL BOARD

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Dear Parent:

Beginning July 1, 2010, you can complete a 2010-2011 Multi-Child Application for Meal Benefits online via the Internet using [www.applyforlunch.com](http://www.applyforlunch.com). The online application is available in English, Spanish, Portuguese and Creole. The entire process should take 15-30 minutes depending on the size of your household, and the information you are required to enter. Be sure to list all the students in the household attending Broward County Schools on the same online application.

You will need to have available and provide the following information during the application process:

- The names, incomes, frequency of incomes, and source of earnings of every member of your household.
- The school, grade, student FSI Numbers and birthdates of every student in your household.
- SNAP or TANF Case Number (Food Stamp Number) if you receive benefits.
- Current Address and Phone Number.
- Your Social Security number and digital signature.
- Information Disclosure decision, allowing or not allowing disclosure of personal information for other programs.
- (Optional) A valid email address or phone number and Child's race and ethnic identity.

If the student you are applying for is homeless, migrant or runaway, you will not be able to apply online. Obtain a physical application at the school the student is enrolled in and contact the School Board of Broward County Homeless Liaison at 754-321-2494, or Migrant Coordinator at 754-321-1414, to obtain additional information on receiving free meals.

Getting started is easy. Go to [www.browardschools.com](http://www.browardschools.com), click on Departments, then Food & Nutrition Services where you will see the link to [applyforlunch.com](http://applyforlunch.com) or you can type in your web browser [www.applyforlunch.com](http://www.applyforlunch.com) and begin the application process.
