### Staff

The Family Counseling Centers are staffed with professional counselors holding Masters Degrees or higher in counseling, social work or psychology with extensive experience in individual, group, and family counseling. Counseling services are available in English, Spanish, Portuguese and Creole.

### Services

The Family Counseling Program provides short-term individual, family, and group counseling, addressing a variety of problem areas, including family issues (communication, divorce/separation, abandonment, parenting skills, domestic violence, abuse, bereavement/loss); social issues (self-esteem, bullying, peer pressure, conflict resolution); emotional issues (anxiety/depression, eating disorders, crisis intervention, anger management, stress management, mild substance abuse); and school issues (study skills, school anxiety/phobia, attention deficit disorder, learning disorders, attendance, behavior).

Appointments for day and evening counseling sessions can be arranged by contacting the Family Counseling Administration Office at 754-321-1590.

### Who is Eligible?

Services are available to any family that resides in Broward County and has a school-aged child enrolled in school.
